ADMISSION PATHWAYS TO ECU

The admission process can vary, based on whether you are in Year 12, your educational qualifications and the course for which you are applying for.

Please note there are minimum academic and English requirements for all courses at ECU, and some also have additional prerequisites and/or special admission requirements. Please refer to the Course Entry requirements for your course at ecuworldready.com.au. Another component to entering into an ECU course is meeting English competency of which applicants have a variety of options. To view these please see our website ecuworldready.com.au/english-competency

If you are unsure we recommend you contact us for a personal consultation about your options with one of our experienced Future Students staff.

SCHOOL LEAVERS

For all Year 12 students applying for ECU courses, you will need to meet English competency as well as achieve WACE (Western Australian Certificate of Education).

If you are unsure of your pathway, our Future Students team is available to discuss course requirements and entry options specific to your interests.

ATAR Students

Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) is a ranking based on eligible subjects studied in Year 12. If your ATAR doesn't meet entry requirements for the course you've chosen, you have some options:

- If you've attended a school on our ECU Access list, your selection rank may be adjusted upwards and you may meet entry requirements for an undergraduate course. Please search ECU Access list at www.ecu.edu.au for more information
- Alternatively, you may apply for consideration via our Experience Based Entry Scheme pathway
- Or, you can search for another course with a lower ATAR requirement
- Or, you may be eligible for our UniPrep course which we recommend you include as a preference on your application.

You can use the Experience Based Entry Scheme pathway if you're currently in Year 12 and:

- You had a near-miss ATAR for your chosen course; or
- You haven't generated an ATAR but you've passed 3 ATAR subjects + 1 General subject

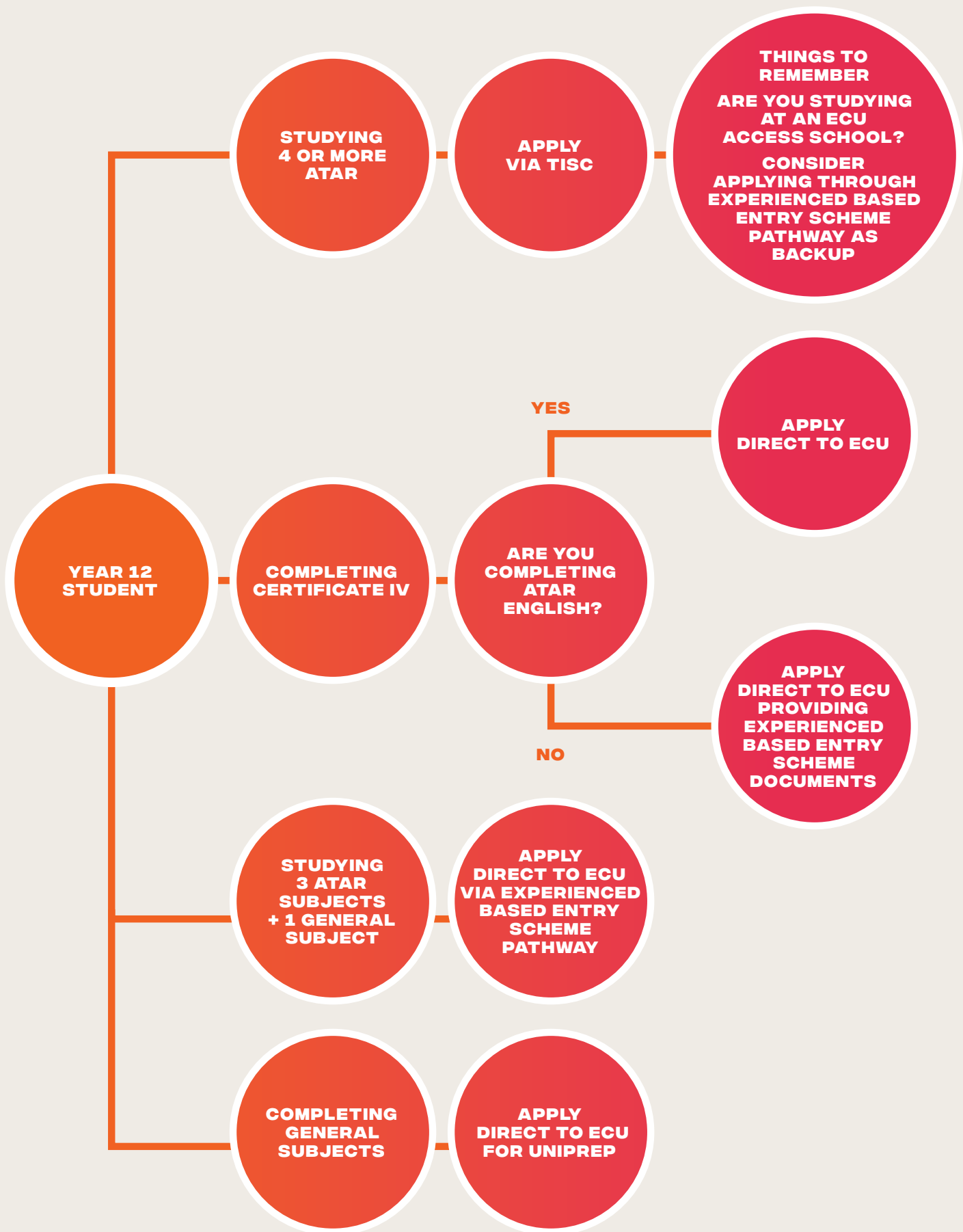
And

- You've completed WACE
- You meet the English competency requirements
- You satisfy any prerequisites for the course you want to apply for

If you are a current Year 12 ATAR student seeking admission for Semester 1, please submit your course application via TISC. If you are also applying through our Experienced Based Entry Scheme pathway then please apply direct to ECU as well.

If you don't have an ATAR, but satisfy English competency, please submit your application and documentation at ecuworldready.com.au/apply

UNIVERSITY PREPARATION COURSES (UNIPREP)

Our range of UniPrep courses provide an admission pathway to many of our undergraduate courses and are available to all prospective domestic students. Australian citizens, holders of a Permanent Humanitarian Visa, Permanent Residents and New Zealand citizens are eligible to study in a Commonwealth Supported place, making the UniPrep course FREE. HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENT APPLICANTS

(includes study at a university or a non-university higher education provider)

You may meet the minimum admission requirements for study at ECU. International university qualifications may also satisfy academic requirements; however you may be required to successfully complete a recognised English test.

Apply direct to ECU via our online Applicant Portal at ecuworldready.com.au/apply

VET STUDY APPLICANTS

If you have completed a Certificate III from a registered training organisation (RTO), you may be eligible to commence your ECU studies starting off with our UniPrep course. This is a great option for those who have had extended time away from studies or wish to build their confidence in university-level study by teaching them the required skills for academic success.

Alternatively, if you've completed a Certificate IV, you can apply direct to us for an undergraduate course. Applicants must also meet English competency dependent on the course they are applying for.

SPECIAL TERTIARY ADMISSIONS TEST (STAT)

Available to anyone who is 20 years of age before 1 March in the year in which they wish to commence studies. The STAT is a national test for mature age people designed to assess aptitude for learning in a tertiary environment. For more information and to book, please visit tisc.edu.au

EXPERIENCE BASED ENTRY SCHEME PATHWAY

ECU's Experience Based Entry Scheme pathway assesses an applicant on a variety of measures including academic history, relevant experience including work and life skills.

As an applicant, you are asked to provide:

- Your academic records
- Two written references with at least one being a recent professional/work/school reference
- An introductory letter
- Your resumé

You may be offered a place in the course of your choice or the UniPrep course.

Our Experience Based Entry Scheme pathway is only available to domestic applicants and is not available for all courses.

ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER STUDENTS

ECU's Aboriginal Recruitment Coordinator will discuss your entry options and course application process, including any further assessment of core skills if you don't meet minimum entry requirements.

Kurongkurl Katitjin's Student Success Team will also reach out with tailored support and information once you have made the decision to join us here at ECU.
