



Outstanding student support

We are here to make sure everyone has the best chance to succeed and be happy at university. Every student is offered a range of services that could include extra support to improve academic skills, counselling support, mentoring programs, or career and job advice.

Tuition and fees


Tuition fees vary and will depend on whether a student is full-time or part-time and what they are studying. Most undergraduate degrees are subsidised by the Government. These are called Commonwealth-Supported places. The student pays a part of the tuition and the Government pays the rest. Students can defer the payment of their part of the fees through the HECS-HELP scheme. This is a loan that students repay through the tax system only when their income reaches the repayment threshold. In 2022, this threshold was an annual income of \$48,361.


Student Services and Amenities Fee (SSAF)

The SSAF is charged for each term in which you are enrolled and is used to provide important services and amenities to students both on and off campus. Eligible students have the option of deferring this fee through the SA-HELP loan scheme. SSAF fees depend on a student's status as part-time or full-time, on-campus or online. The maximum total amount of SSAF in 2023 was \$326.



Other expenses

Apart from the obvious costs of accommodation, food and transport, other costs to consider include textbooks, computer equipment and software, stationery, field trips, uniforms or other course-specific expenses such as art materials, musical equipment or travel for work placements.





Scholarships

What are scholarships?

Scholarships can make a real difference to the cost of studying.

There are all kinds of scholarships available for:

- High academic achievement

Why should you apply?

Scholarships range from \$600 to help you buy some textbooks all the way through to \$60,000 over four years which could help you pay your accommodation costs.

On campus - UniLodge

On-campus residential colleges at Lismore and Coffs Harbour offer fully furnished shared apartments. Facilities at each college include internet access and on-site laundries, indoor and outdoor entertainment areas. Weekly room rental starts from \$183 (in 2022).




