Here are four fantastic reasons to make University Accommodation your new home:

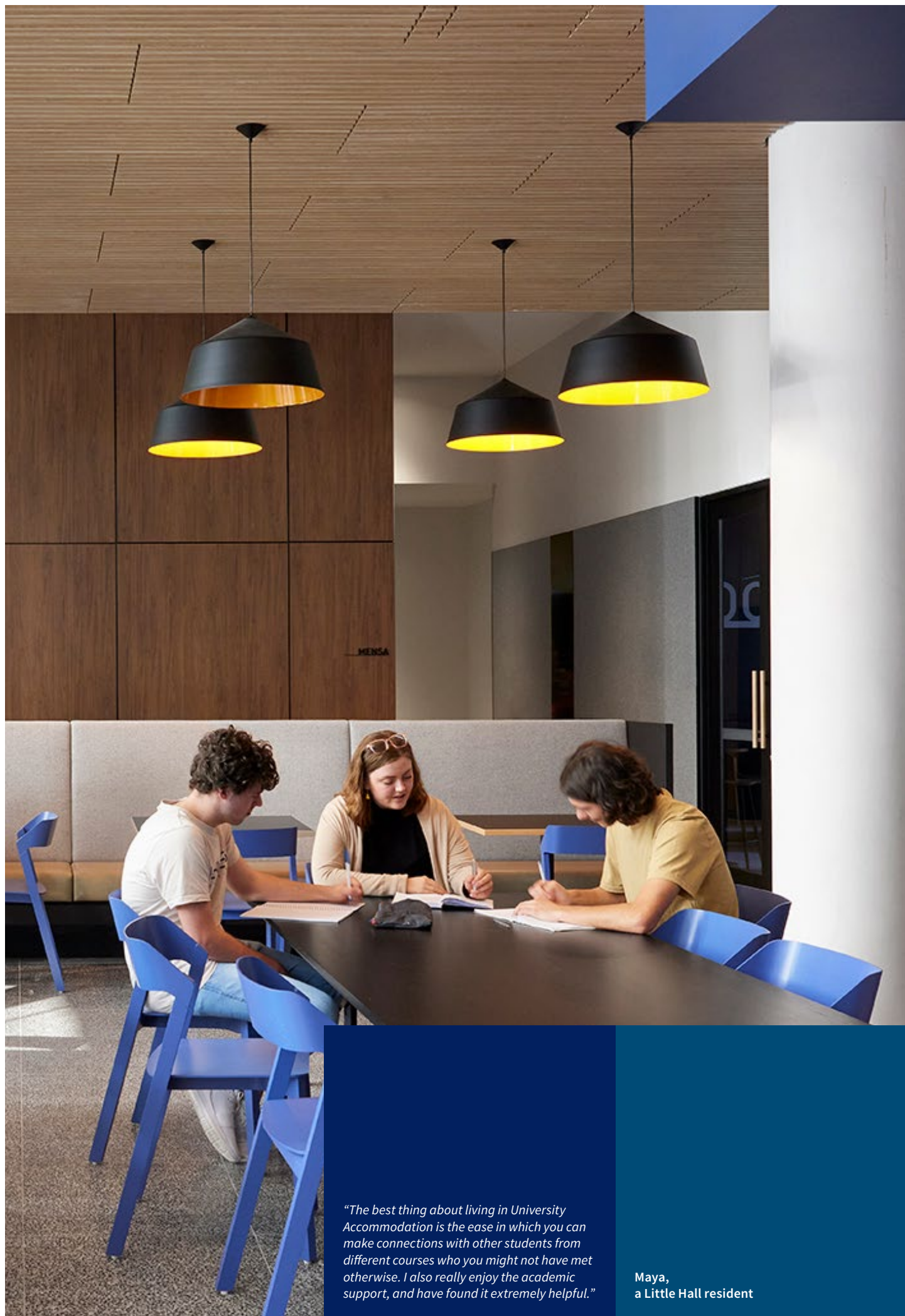
1. **Stress-free accommodation** – utilities and unlimited internet are included in your rent, we don't require a rental reference and our application process is an easy, one-off form.

How to Apply

You can secure your place in University Accommodation in three easy steps:

1. Create your account on our online application portal – it takes about 10 minutes.
2. Nominate your preferences, pay the application fee* and submit your application.
3. Accept your accommodation offer within 3 days of receiving it.

*Application fee is non-refundable

When you apply, you can nominate 3 to 5 accommodation preferences.

Applications for semester 1 open on 1 August and applications for semester 2 open on 1 April each year.
